

KS5 Dress expectations

Students in our 6th Form have chosen to continue their study with us and therefore, by default, agree to our 6th Form Dress expectations. If students do not adhere to these expectations, they will be asked to return home to change, or parents will be asked to bring in a change of clothes.

The overall guiding principle is; dress and appearance should be appropriate for a work/business environment.

Male students

- Trousers/chinos(no jogging bottoms)
- Shirt or polo shirt with collar or 'grandad' collar
- Tailored shorts
- Shoes, pumps or sandals (must have a support at the heel). No flip-flops or trainers

Female students

- Trousers (no leggings or jogging bottoms)
- Skirt/dress, no shorter than mid-thigh
- Shorts (in the summer), no shorter than mid-thigh
- Full length smart top, blouse, shirt, polo shirt with straps no less than 2 inches wide
- Shoes, pumps or sandals (must have support at the heel). No flip-flops or trainers

All 6th Form students

- No Beach wear
- No extremes of fashion or hair colour
- No obtrusive or offensive logos/slogans
- No visible piercings other than one pair of earrings. (studs or small hoops)
- Students should not wear headphones while walking around the school site
- We do not expect tattoos to be visible

In all matters relating to uniform, it is the school's prerogative to decide what is appropriate. We reserve the right to amend this policy in light of new fashion trends/issues.

The Executive Principal may grant exceptions to any of the above, but only where this is required as a matter of sincere religious observance or strict medical advice and where this can be substantiated by a letter from the leader of the relevant religious community or medical practitioner.
