

2 LIEUTENANT COLONEL DAVISON LANCS Episkopi and Troodos Station Commander Chair of St John's School Governors Committee

Lieutenant Colonel Davison joined the Army in 1985. Early service included postings to Catterick, Germany (including Berlin), Colchester, Londonderry and Cyprus. He deployed on operations to Northern Ireland, Cyprus, and the Balkans; and has taken part in overseas exercises in Belize, Canada and Kenya. He was also an instructor at the Infantry Battle School and at the Military Academy Sandhurst. He commissioned from RSM 1 KORBR in 2005 and has subsequently taken part in numerous operations and exercises including deployments to Iraq and Afghanistan. He was assigned as Episkopi and Troodos Station Commander in September 2018 in what should be his final appointment.

The role of Station Commander is intimately linked to the local Schools and Lieutenant Colonel Davison is delighted to have been appointed as the Chair of St John's School Governors Committee. Although he has focused on his Army career for the past 33 years he is keen to use his experience and management skills to continue the work of his predecessor in leading an effective Committee and to strengthen the relationship between the Governors and the School.
