Mountain biking

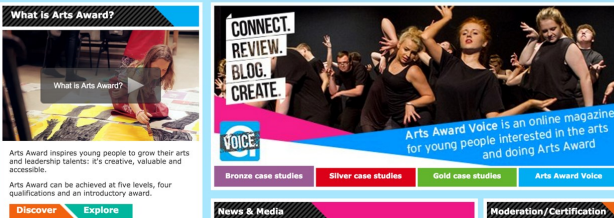
This club is coming soon including bike maintenance and safe riding

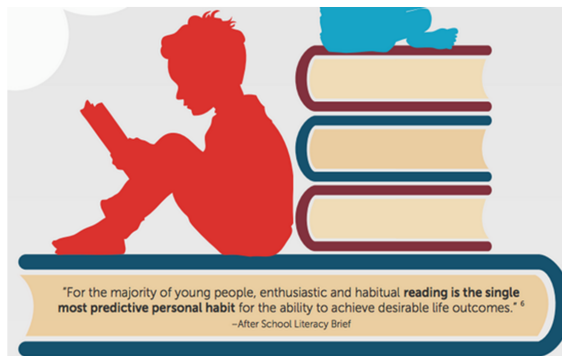
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All Y10 students have the option of gaining their D of E Bronze award or a Sports leaders qualification through core PE



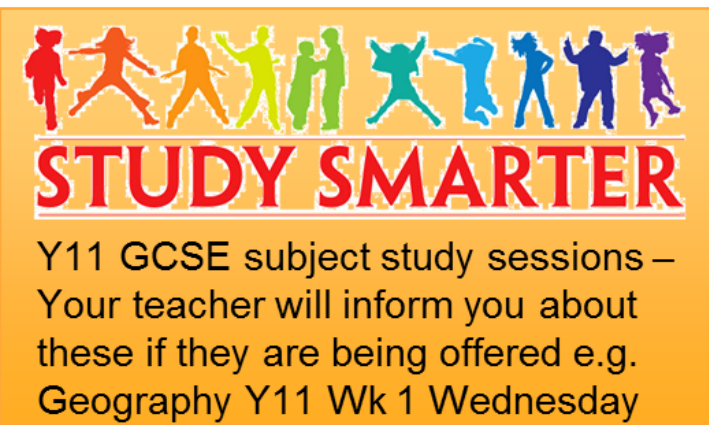
Get Involved – Reading for Pleasure @ SJS Challenge

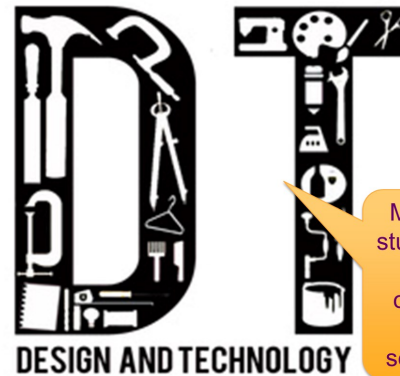
Bronze and Silver will run this year
