Last weekend a large numbers of our students headed east to compete in the Dhekelia Dash. This excellent community event was enjoyed by our school contingent, who also enjoyed competitive success! Well done and thank you to those who represented our school, for the organisers who put on this excellent event and to our staff who gave up a significant portion of their weekend.



This week welcomed visitors from the United Kingdom who undertook a three day in depth Health and Safety Inspection. The visit explored all aspects of Health and Safety at St John's School, it included a site inspection, a thorough audit of our paperwork and record keeping, a school evacuation and deep dives into Science, PE, Design and Technology. The inspection was a very positive experience and provided a favourable evaluation with some clear areas for improvement that included updating emergency signage, ensuring storage areas are tidy and that we continue to push for identified areas of work needed to ensure the safety of all at school.

On Wednesday our Lead Teachers attended King Richard School for the expansion of the Lead Teacher programme. As an initiative established at St John's School, it's potential has been recognised by the Department for Children's Services and is now being rolled out across Cyprus and MOD Schools worldwide. The expansion of this programme will provide additional support and expertise for our school, whilst also acknowledging another example of best practice proudly originating from our teaching community.

Elsewhere this week we enjoyed the opportunity to host Year 4 from Episkopi Primary School on Wednesday, as they watched a short Pantomime production performed by Year 7. Key Stage 3 took part in the national Junior Maths Challenge, whilst on Thursday, it was great to see a small number of parents attend our Cyber Security Brunch in partnership with CJPU and J6 Cyber Security.

This weekend is the first of a series of May Bank Holidays that will see the school closed on Monday 1st May to both students and staff. We look forward to welcoming students to school on Tuesday 2nd May and hope that, despite the pressures many of you in our military community are facing at present with operations in Sudan, that you manage some time together over this extended weekend.
