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Year 8 Mathematics

On Monday 10 July, Year 8 will sit their end of year examination in Mathematics. We will use this examination data alongside the Progress Tests that they are to complete in the coming weeks to determine which set they will be placed in in Year 9.

The assessment is 90 minutes long and all students will complete the same assessment so that we can standardise the scores across the year group.

All students with examination access arrangements; including extra time, readers and scribes will have these available to them.

As a department we appreciate that there have been some unavoidable changes to classes and teachers this year and we would like to use these assessments to ensure that this is not the case next year, and that each one of our students is placed in the correct group from September and receives high quality, consistent teaching across the whole of the year.

Changes to our assessment and reporting approach at Key Stage 3

The way we set targets and monitor progress will be changed for the start of next year as we overhaul the pathway system. This overhaul comes following discussion with all participating stakeholders, who have raised concerns around the understanding of the current pathway system, it's suitability and accuracy in tracking and reporting progress.

From September, each student will be given a target for each subject separately based on previous results at KS2 and the CATs* assessments they do on arrival. The targets will be focused towards the GCSE exam targets.

There will be three target bands as follows:

- ⇒ **Foundation** for students who will be expected to achieve target grade 3-5 at GCSE
- ⇒ Intermediate for students who will be expected to achieve target grade 7-9 at GCSE
- ⇒ Higher for students who will be expected to achieve target grade 7-9 at GCSE

The target should not limit the possibility of aiming higher. All students will be expected to work hard to achieve or exceed their target! There will be opportunities in the next school year to discuss this with your teachers.

*CATs stands for Cognitive Abilities Tests. They are designed to assess a pupil's ability in three different areas: verbal (thinking with words); quantitative (thinking with numbers); and non-verbal (thinking with shapes and space).

Further information will follow in the coming weeks, again in the new academic year and together with future target setting information and reporting.

Year 10 and 12 End of year exam results and reports

Next week students in Year 10 and 12 begin their end of year examinations. Upon completion we will be releasing their results along with their end of year reports on the following dates:

- Year 12 on Friday 14th July at 1330hrs in the school hall
- Year 10 on Tuesday 18th July at 1330hrs in the school hall.

You are invited to come to a session to collect the results with your son/daughter. There will also be an opportunity to ask questions or discuss the next steps.
