Transport Arrangements for Entitled Students

There are four possibilities on any one day:

- 1. If your child only has a morning exam then they will come into school as normal and leave at the end of the day as they normally would with the rest of the school students.
- 2. If your child only has an afternoon exam*, we will make arrangements for them to be picked up and bused into school for approximately 12:30. They will then be taken back by the exam bus at the end of their exam.
- 3. If they have both a morning and an afternoon exam then they will come into school as normal for an 08:00 start and will return on the exam bus following their afternoon exam. This is a very long day for the students and they need sufficient water and food to sustain them. There will be an air-conditioned space for them to rest in between 14:00 and the start of the afternoon exam. They are also allowed to sign out between exams and walk to the shops to buy lunch.
- 4. Up to and including **Friday 24 May 2024**, if your son or daughter does not have an exam they will be expected to attend lessons as normal and leave at 14:00.

Sixth Form students will be expected to attend all their timetabled lessons on days they don't have an exam up to and including **Friday 24 May 2024**. Up to that point, students must attend school full time following one of the four arrangements above. After this date they will be given the choice to study at home or come into school and attend timetabled lessons and use the study room. Teachers may request to see them for revision sessions during this time and we would ask for your support with encouraging your son or daughter to attend these sessions.

Transport will continue to be provided into school for either morning (as normal) or afternoon exams as outlined below.

Students must not book holidays or leave island up to and including **Wednesday 26 June 2024** due to examination contingency dates. This is a requirement of all exam boards.

PLEASE NOTE: If any student misses the transport provided for any reason, it is the responsibility of the parent to arrange transport for their child to school.
