



Using the MCAS App you will now be able to find our emerging extra curricular enrichment opportunities for students.



Annual Consent Form for school trips and other off-site activities

Following the successful implementation of our annual consent form which enables you to give permission in advance for your child/children to take part in activities locally, such as outdoor learning, and school trips further afield we are now able to link this to the My Child at School app.

Please can I direct you to the 'consents' section on the MCAS app for you to agree to giving consent for your child to attend school trips / off site activities. Parents/carers will still be contacted in advance of school trips with fuller excursion details. This provides a further opportunity to withdraw consent if applicable.

The trips and activities covered by this consent include:

- All visits (including residential trips) which take place during the school day, during holidays or at the weekend
- Adventure activities at any time
- Off-site sporting fixtures outside the school day

You can, if you wish, tell the school that you do not want your child to take part in any specific school trip or activity.

Further written parental consent will not be requested from you for off-site activities offered by the school.

By giving consent on MCAS you are signing to say you are happy for your child / children to:

- a) To take part in school trips and other activities that take place off school premises; and
- b) To be given first aid or urgent medical treatment during any school trip or activity.
