#### **Headteacher's Surgery - Akrotiri Hive**

On Thursday 27th November 0900—1000 hrs, parents and/or members of the BFC community are welcome to drop into the Akrotiri Hive, without appointment, to meet the Headteacher, Colin Guyton, to discuss any ideas or issues concerning St John's School.

This approach draws similarities from the MP Local Constituency Surgeries you may be familiar with in the UK and it is hoped that it will prove a useful opportunity to share ideas that help improve the provision we provide to the young people in our care.



#### Classroom access arrangements through coloured paper

In recent years there has been an increase in student requests for learning materials to be printed on various colours of paper. This growing demand has increased staff workload and pressures on the day of examinations. The Joint Council of Qualifications (JCQ) who oversee national examinations such as GCSE and GCE's have ruled that 'alternative ways of working should be explored, such as the use of coloured overlay or the candidate wearing coloured glasses' (JCQ.2025).

Making such a change for students in Year 11, 12 and 13 in the months before their exams would be unfair and we will continue to support students in these years with their current usual way of working by supporting them with different colours of paper. For students in younger years we are adopting the rule of JCQ and will cease to provide learning materials on different colours of paper opting instead to explore other ways of working.

All students who have a diagnosed need to use different coloured paper have been provided with an overlay, which they should use instead. We have also ordered, and begun to issue, different glasses which allow access to learning materials in the desired colour preferred by the student.
