

### **Timetable Changes**

As your child may have reported we have suffered from a number of unavoidable staff absences over the past couple of weeks, which have compounded the impact of two long term staff absences. Teachers available for supply are in high demand across all of our Cyprus schools and this offers an additional challenge in ensuring we adequately cover classes.

Aided by a reduction in the number of students on roll I have taken the decision to reduce the number of classes from three to two in Year 7, 8 and 9. This change will come into effect on Monday 8th December. Class sizes will remain significantly below the UK average at 23 students per class.

Making this change will allow me greater flexibility and improved resilience in covering for absent colleagues with teachers known to our students.

In addition to the timetable changes I have also been successful in recruiting a very well qualified former Head of English and an experienced teacher of Geography to provide cover in these subject area. They will both be joining us in January (if not sooner) and add much needed capacity within this core subject.

I am so sorry for the recent staff absences and hope that I maintain your confidence in our efforts to do everything I can to maintain stability for our students, which is underpinned by a safe, calm and purposeful learning environment.
